Today's study was written by me, so let's read it. The importance of continuous revelation. Paragraph 1 Continuous revelation is the living proof that God did not shut up after ancient times.

Without revelation, we would be limited only to the past, trying to apply ancient instructions to a world in constant change. The revelations received anywhere in the world can be revealed instantly to all people who have access to the internet.

Good evening, everyone. Good evening. Congratulations on the conduction.

Very cool. Congratulations on this initiative. It's really very good.

This question, how can we feel and recognize the voice of God speaking to us in today's days. There are two things that catch my attention in today's days. The first is the question of the Sealed Book of Mormon.

We can feel it. The first time I read the Sealed Book of Mormon, I felt something different. Continuing to read and participating in the meetings, I could feel more and more that it was the voice of God speaking, not only to me, but also to his people, to the people of God in these last days, especially now in the second COVID.

This is an eye-opener to let us understand that the prophet that the Lord chooses and uses is essential to our spiritual growth. And I just wanted to say that it confirms that that scripture reading in this lesson, where it said, and I think that's a brilliant summary for what this particular section of the study brings to me. We were warned before, in preparation. So it wouldn't be anything different. That's why the Lord doesn't change.

He is the same yesterday, today, and for the next generations as well. As you said at the beginning, we also have the conference, which is also a prophecy for our days, that something will happen there. But it's up to us to prepare ourselves.

It's no use just having these revelations or prophecies and not doing our part. We have to do our part as well. So it wouldn't be different in our generation, answering the question.

This passage highlights that revelation is a divine gift that transcends human understanding. Prophets receive light to clarify spiritual truths and warn the people when they deviate. Each revelation is a bridge between heaven and earth, offering us the chance to understand God's purpose and walk with faith.

Without revelation, we would be spiritually blind, guided only by our limited wisdom. Paragraph 3 question. How do the revelations given to the prophets strengthen our faith and understanding of eternal truths?

Good evening, everyone. The current revelations strengthen our faith because we see their fulfillment many times on the same day, or in the same week, or in the same year. While other denominations claim to have prophets, but there are no revelations, you don't see anything fulfilled.

The revelations given by the prophets act as a direct channel of communication of God's will to his people. It is a way that the Heavenly Father found to communicate with his children, guiding us, consoling us, and confirming hidden truths to our own eyes, resulting in a stronger faith and a deeper understanding of the divine laws. And it is through these guidelines and instructions that we receive comfort, hope in difficult times, repentance and, above all, warnings.

For the prophets warn us about dangers and expose our mistakes and call us to repentance, which is crucial for our spiritual growth. And finally, the revelations, through our prophets, make that mist that obscures our mortal vision dissipate, revealing the spiritual truths that were until then hidden to us, thus solidifying our faith on our rock, which is our revelation. Hello, good evening. Sister Carla said everything, but as Johnny said, I'm going to take a look. This topic you brought up is very good, because many times we fail by not looking at the revelations.

So it is very important for us to remember the revelations and seek understanding. In relation to understanding, many times we have difficulty in some certain doctrinal points. And I remember when Brother Maurício explains, even when we have doubts and our head is in such a whirlwind of entanglement, of difficulties, of trying to understand that certain point, but he teaches in a way that expands our vision and our understanding.

That is why it is so necessary, the prophets, and it is so necessary the revelation. Even the revelation without the prophets would be very difficult for us to follow the path. And here in the text you say that he knows both past and future things.

So only the prophet, many times, to be able to try to explain to us many doctrinal points that we do not understand. That is why the importance of the prophets and the revelations.

Thank you very much. Let's move on to our reading for paragraph 4. The Book of Mormon confirms that the Lord did not cease to speak to his children.

In the Book of Moses, chapter 17, verses 22 and 23, we read, Behold, the Lord God spoke to me, saying, there is no end to my works or my words. This powerful revelation shows that God continues to reveal truths in all ages, expanding the understanding of his people according to their faith and spiritual preparation. The same God who spoke to Moses and to the ancient prophets continues to instruct and correct his people in the last days through Mauricio Bello.

In addition to continuing to restore the forgotten truths, so we see that the revelation is continuous and eternal, as well as the love of God for his children. Question number 4. What blessings do we receive when we believe and accept that God still speaks to his people through new messengers?

Again. The blessings are concentrated mainly in the certainty that we have of the divine presence, showing us the direction we should follow in our days, renewal and hope for our soul and a brighter path to our salvation and a greater personal and collective improvement as a Church. Thank you.

Thank you, Sister Ingrid. I'll be very brief because I've already answered one and I see there are others there waiting. But what blessings we receive are the feelings of joy and happiness knowing that we are connected to our Creator through his messengers.

And of course, that's proved by the fruits that the messenger, the prophet has for us. And that is the truth and it brings those feelings of the Lord very close to us. Thank you.

We also receive the blessings of protection against mistakes and misguidance, that man himself is tempted by Satan to change the word.

We also gain the feeling of direction and purpose in our life, unity with the people of the Lord. And we also gain the blessing of receiving new knowledge, because by accepting and believing that we have a prophet and that he receives the revelation of God, we will have new learnings. And these new learnings will give us a more intimate relationship with God.

The blessings we receive by believing and accepting that God still speaks to his people through new messages. You speak here in the passage that says, this powerful revelation shows that God continues to reveal truths in all eras, expanding the understanding of his people according to their spiritual faith and preparation. Expanding the mind, expanding the understanding of things, this is very important in the Second Conflict, because most of us here already have some religious experience.

Many of us are from the South, others are from other denominations, from RLDS, or Lote do Tempo, other Mormon denominations in the United States. And sometimes we think we already know a lot. When the Second Conflict comes, when Brother Mauricio comes and says so many things, it expands our minds.

The question of the eternal circle, the question of the united order. You say here, restoring forgotten truths. You use this excerpt that touched me a lot.

There are many forgotten truths. They were impoverished; they were squandered by apostasy since the death of Prophet Joseph Smith. Something that caught my attention.

These are the blessings we receive. The expansion of the mind, the expansion of understanding, and also the question of the context of the scriptures. It caught my attention too.

That's what I wanted to comment on.

Thank you very much. I followed the reading of paragraph 5. Although the Lord speaks to humanity through the prophets, He also speaks individually to each one of us.

The Holy Spirit is the personal messenger of the revelation, bringing consolation, correction and spiritual confirmation. When we study the scriptures, pray with sincerity and seek to live with dignity, we become more sensitive to the gentle and delicate voice of the Spirit. This personal revelation strengthens our faith and helps us to discern between truth and deception.

Thus, we not only hear about God, but we truly know Him by our own experience. Question of paragraph number 5. What can we do to increase our spiritual sensitivity and recognize the voice of the Spirit in our life?

We can be more connected with the scriptures in the spirit of prayer. We can be praying, fasting. But within this comment I would like to make, this paragraph is talking about personal revelation.

Today we see many denominations and people saying they receive revelation. They wouldn't need a prophet. But that's not how it works.

We can receive personal revelation for our lives, but for the people of God there is a spokesperson. It's the prophet. We have to know how to differentiate this.

To get closer to this sensitivity, to have this communication with God, as I said, it's always praying, fasting, reading the scriptures, doing all the pertinent things within the class.

And so if we just like take time to like read the scriptures like spend more time out in nature we can really see God's hand in everything. And once we once we let go of all these worldly distractions, we can start hearing God's voice more clearly and seeing His hand in everything. Thank you.

It isn't just hearing the still small voice of the spirit, but it is responding to that spirit. This has happened throughout my life, and I know it has for each one of you. In 1968, because of God's communication to me, I left my homeland, Australia, and came to the United States.

This was unknown territory for me. I had to trust in the Lord for so many things. And so throughout my life, my life has been protected, saved.

I have been healed. I have come to the knowledge of the second invitation. We were privileged to hear about that very early on.

And so many things have happened since we have been in the second invitation. This is because of the still small voice of the spirit, and it's God's direction to us. We all have access to that spirit.

I know sometimes the Lord has different callings and responsibilities that we may not feel that we really had any choice but to respond. But whatever it takes in faith and responding to that spirit, it's such a blessing in our own lives, and it can, I hope and pray, be a blessing to other people also. So it's just so important to be in tune with the Lord so that we can recognize that spirit and respond to it.

Hello, good evening. Hi, folks. First, I'm going to congratulate Ingrid for the wonderful study, but for a wonderful conduct.

This meeting was well conducted, with a lot of calm, with a lot of capacity, with a clear reading, at a speed that is possible to understand. The subtitles are delivering the translation very well. So, congratulations to Ingrid, for you who is not yet a member of the second invitation, not in the official terms of having been baptized, confirmed, but I know that you are a member in your heart already, and the conversion is in your heart.

Rituals of passage, baptism, confirmation are necessary, because that's how God instituted them, but there are no acts that replace a truly converted heart. Ingrid is a construction, an evolution of someone who did not come from any other religion. Ingrid was never Mormon, and maybe I'm wrong, but I think Ingrid didn't even belong to any other religion or dogma of faith.

But the Holy Spirit allowed herself to have a personal revelation, allowed the Gospel to enter her heart, and for the Holy Spirit to do the work of conversion. And that's what the revelation does, answering the sixth question, it helps us to remain firm, both the personal revelation and the revelation that God gives us through prophets. And protected, because as others have said, the Lord warns his children of the calamities that are to come.

Today we know that in a short time we will live a calamity such that people will leave their countries to take refuge in countries that allow them to have a dignified life, to have food, to have a roof. This time is coming, it has been prophesied, we have revelations about it. As

we had the revelation preceding COVID, the grasshopper plague, the bankruptcies, we have been warned so many times.

And in this spiritually confused world, the revelation is easily perceived as true because it converges with the Scriptures. No revelation that a prophet delivers, saying that he is a prophet, needs to find a basis in all the past Scriptures and form a kind of junction of logic of all the others. So everything we witness in the Second Invitation is easily proven through the Scriptures.

Prophecies that are in the Book of Mormon and that are fulfilled now with the book sealed in our days. Prophecies that are in the Book of Mormon and that are fulfilled now in our days, from where would the one who would read the sealed part of the sealed plates of Mormon come from? Revelations are a continuity of what God has for us.

And the one who allows himself to believe in something confused, loose from the Scriptures, something that has no basis in the Scriptures, this person is like a bottle of glass thrown into the sea, where any wave, depending on the storm, will take it wherever it goes, without direction, without destination. That is why people easily get lost in spirituality, because they believe in many things that have no basis in the Scriptures. And they believe very easily.

But when we see in the Second Invitation, and we have already seen Brother Mauricio explain things to us, with the Scriptures, where all the Scriptures talk to each other, as well as the Revelations in the Second Invitation, they fit so perfectly, there we have the confirmation that we have a safe base, which is the Scriptures. And then we will not be lost, only the one who does not allow the Holy Spirit to act in his heart and does not allow himself to be a student, because he wants to live, to be an eternal master. But in the Gospel of the Lord, we are students, we will only learn, we will only live the true Gospel, the one who is willing to learn the truths that God brings from time to time.

This one is not lost.

Thank you. And Benoit, thank you very much. Benoit, everybody, brothers and sisters.

I thank you, Sister Ingrid, for your lesson today. It is beautiful and gives a good example of what we are to do to listen to God's message through his messengers. Anyway, to answer the question here, how does God's Revelation help us to remain firm and protected in an increasingly spiritual confused world?

I would say that it strengthens our faith. And the example of the Book of Moses, chapter 3, verse 70, says a lot in that, that we should understand that if we have no doubt or fear, that

these things will happen through the messenger that God sends. And it encourages us to remain firm in our belief and our faith in what God is doing to lead his people on in this second invitation.

And that we listen to the commands and we keep the commandments. That is very important that we keep those commandments that we are given. And we are given line upon line to understand gradually, little by little, his will for all mankind.

Look, I'm here again. Another little word that caught my attention in the question you asked about protection. God's Revelation helps us to remain protected in an increasingly spiritually confused world.

So, I met the Second Invitation in 2019, before the pandemic started. And one thing that scared me a lot was the pandemic. And I already knew the Second Invitation in March 2019.

And in January 2020, I joined the Seão Project. Eight months later, studying, learning with Mau Maurício, with Munjone, with everyone. I went to Palhaça two or three times during this period.

I left Brasília to be able to meet in person. All that was happening in my heart, in my mind, was boiling. So, when the pandemic came, I felt very safe.

I was very amazed with everything. In Brazil, 4,000 people died a day. And I had a very strong hope in my heart.

We still didn't have the vaccine. But even so, my heart was feeling safe, because I had met the Second Invitation. And I believed that I had a great task, a great job to do this work.

Even if it was small, it would be great for me. And this question touched my heart a lot. Because even today, I feel very protected when I hear the prophet, when I hear the revelations.

More than I hear, I read them and observe them. So that's what I wanted to comment on. This protection is very important.

We can feel protected with the revelation of God. Notably, this current revelation that Brother Maurício has already received and will receive even more. Thank you.

Recognizing the importance of continuous revelation is recognizing the constant love of God. He is not a distant God, but a present Father who guides and speaks to His children in all generations. For He is the same yesterday, today and forever.

When we open our hearts to hear and follow His revelations, whether they be given by prophets or by the Holy Spirit, we become participants of His work and instruments to bring light to others. Revelation is the foundation of a living faith and the proof that the Gospel is eternal and current. May each one of us seek daily to hear the voice of the Lord and act according to His will.

Last question of the night. Question number 7. Are we willing to seek personal revelation and follow with faith the words that the Lord continues to reveal today?

Thank you, Sister Ingrid. I'd like to share my ideas about what our topic is all about. And I'm grateful for the inspiration of the Holy Spirit through the scriptures, because prior to Jesus Christ's death, He promised His apostles that He would not leave them.

And He said in John 14, 26, I will send you the Holy Ghost and He shall teach you all things and bring all things to your remembrance. I'd like to thank Sister Melba who shared her experience about the importance of the Spirit by becoming sensitive to the still small voice. When I was a missionary of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, I have experienced a lot of tragic events in my life.

I was able to experience the greatest earthquake that hit the Philippines, the eruption of Mount Pinatubo and all the many typhoons. And the only thing strengthened me is the inspiration that comes from the Holy Spirit. As we become sensitive to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, it will save us.

It will help us follow the teachings and admonition of our living prophets. So I know, brethren, that only through the still small voice, we could hear the words of God, which made me successful in my missionary work when I was a young man in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. However, since the sealed book came in, which in my 40 years of membership in the Church of Jesus Christ, I have been looking forward of a living share.

I am grateful that through the instrumentality of Brother Mauricio Berger and having this sealed book translated, my conviction and testimony about the words of God strengthened me because of the coming forth of the sealed book of Mormon. Thank you and good night to all of you.

Today he received a proposal for a job, in which he could not be here with us today, but he decided for himself. If I go to work, I will not participate in the class.

So, it's no use just having the theory, the practice, it will determine if we are really willing. So, this question really makes a lot of sense. And as Brother Sidney said, some words that you put in this study are very reflective and make us rethink and meditate a lot.

I'd just like to make a couple of comments. I'm real short with it. I'm really happy about the study.

I'm really pleased about participation so far. And I agree. If I hadn't listened to the Holy Spirit, I might not have ever been a part of this second invitation at all.

I was in Michigan. I had a really nice place. I had two or three bedrooms.

I had a nice living room, a kitchen, a dining room. All that I would ever want. And I could pay for it easy.

And I listened to the Holy Spirit, and the Spirit said, you've got to move. And so, I had to give up a lot. And I moved down to North Carolina to be in the bedroom for almost four years before I finally got a place to live in.

And my apartment is one bedroom, and Samuel knows just how small it is. But I did that so that I could answer and believe the Word of God when he spoke. And in 2017, I heard the testimony of both Bob Moore and Joseph F.

Smith in a video from an email sent by Samuel, who was asked to send by an apostle of the Church of Christ TL, who doesn't even believe in any of it at all, which is a miracle in itself. Every time he talks about revelation, I feel a chill in my stomach. I feel a tension. Because living in days of a prophet, living in days when there are revelations coming, causes me fear.

Because this means that it is our responsibility to fulfill the revelations and be an obedient and zealous believer. Why do I feel this feeling of fear? Because when I read the Scriptures, I see that the people of the past were wrong about this.

When they did not listen to the revelations, when they did not listen to the words of the prophets, when they ignored the call of God through the prophets, and everything was lost. The prophets were lost; Moses was taken out of the midst of the people. Then the priesthood was lost.

And every time the people are disobedient, everything is lost and the work of God is delayed. So, when they talk about revelations, it is very good to hear that everyone had to say that it is the most wonderful thing, that it is incredible to know that God speaks to us, to know that we live on this day, how wonderful it is. I wonder how wonderful it is for God at this moment.

If God is finding a people who receive his words not only with joy, joy is very important, but receives these words with respect and fear that they must receive, with the commitment that they must fulfill what I am saying. Because I think the following, if we make a mistake now, if we disobey the revelations now, as well as all the commandments of God have a blessing as a result of obedience, all the commandments have a curse of disobedience. And I think, I don't want to be part of a people in which, once again, the story they are going to tell is that it was a disobedient people.

And so the work of God was delayed, once again the priesthood was lost. So, the last paragraph of Ingrid's study, she talks about opening your heart to hear and follow the

revelations. It is much more necessary than reading the revelations, it is necessary to put it in the heart and be willing to follow it.

And for that, it needs all of us, a unity of sacrifice, a true desire. But I say it again, we need to abandon the idea that we are enough and understand that we have a lot to improve, a lot to grow, a lot to evolve. That's why we need to stay together, be together at the conference, because Lermont de Olardo said that the conference has a promise.

It is not certain that something will happen there, it is a yes, it is a condition, it depends on us. It even depends on us if the conference will happen, as it is in the revelation. So, everything is in our hands.

So, when the subject of revelation comes, I feel a certain fear, if I will not be the one who will hinder the work of God, since I am in the current moment of revelations. And how much I am a learner and not wanting to lead God's work with my own perceptions. And that's why we have the President of the United Order, we have the President of the United Order, and we need to lead through the spirit that God guides us to do what we must do.

And as members, we have the duty to listen to them and follow their guidelines. And we know that we are at a time when this has not been done, so much so that we no longer have Brother Maurício with us, because we did not hear. So let us now be diligent with the revelation, so that on July 4, 2026, we have again a prophet with an active voice in our days.

And that this time we can hear him, not contest him, but hear him and follow what God asks us to do. And that's it. Once again, congratulations, Ingrid!
